

IMPORTANT!

40 or 80 Channel: UHF Personal Radio, UHF Licence Free Radio, and UHF 'Communicator'

These low cost hand-held radios operate on the Australian **UHF CB Radio band**. The use of this equipment is governed by Federal legislation the same as all other CB Radio equipment. This legislation includes the allocation of certain channels for specific uses:

- **Channels 5 and 35 are reserved for EMERGENCY USE ONLY**
- Channel 11 is reserved as a Call Channel
- Channels 1 to 8, 31 to 37, 41 to 48 and 71 to 78 are used by Repeater Stations (range extender)
- Channel 40 is used as a Road and Truckies Channel

Heavy penalties can apply for the misuse of legally designated channels, especially the EMERGENCY CHANNELS.

If you use one of these low cost hand-held radios, please be sure to observe the law – it could save a life one day!
